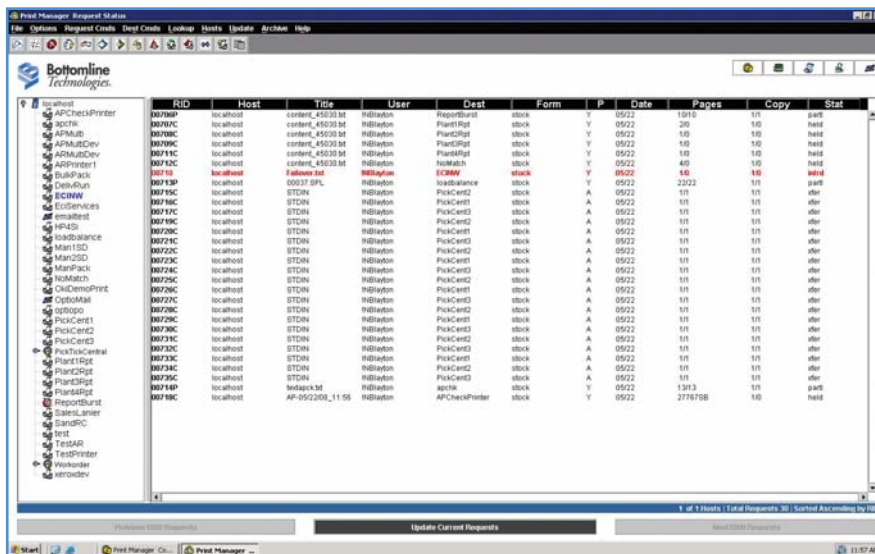

- **Assured delivery of checks and remittance advices** – Ensure print job delivery to secure network printers with specific tracking and event notifications.

- **Printer load balancing** – Eliminate bottlenecks by automatically segmenting and spooling jobs for timely check and remittance advices to multiple printers.
- **Automated fail-over** – Dynamically redirect jobs to other devices when a primary check printer is offline or out of paper.
- **User notification** – Automatically notify AP staff, claims operations personnel and other relevant end users of job destination and status, eliminating unnecessary support calls to ensure checks are printed on schedule in a secure environment.

Organizations can also reap significant cost savings and improve security controls by eliminating the need to manually track lost checks and resubmit them for printing.

Optimize Finance and IT Resources for Both Upstream and Downstream Printer Management

Bottomline Print Manager dynamically distributes the downstream check and remittance workload from your WebSeries server so that financial printer networks are never underused or overburdened. The system automatically identifies the most efficient printer for each job, routing high-volume output to the fastest devices and then confirming that a check run issued to a local network was successful. By applying Print Manager to networks optimized for check and remittance output, organizations can eliminate lost checks and other payment delays resulting purely from printer issues, while improving cash management controls and reducing the number of duplicate check printing errors.

Additionally, Print Manager will automatically spool large check runs to multiple devices, redirect jobs if the primary printer is unavailable and alert end-users to any changes. If a device fails, Print Manager automatically redirects or reprints the job without accessing your ERP or other financial host system, or requiring IT assistance.

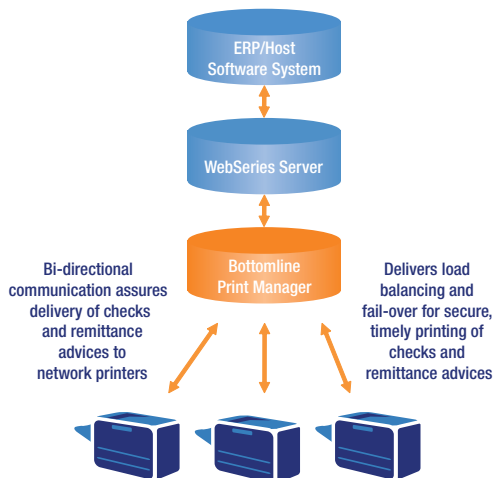

Robust Statistical Reporting

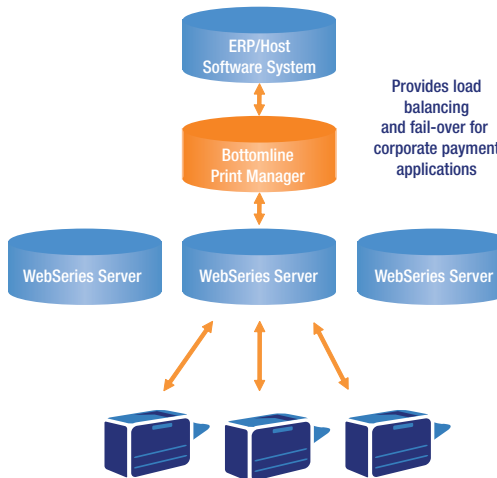
